

## New Edition of Sea Scout® Manual Available November 2010

The new edition of the Sea Scout Manual, No. 33239, is now available for purchase through Supply. Pick up your personal copy, retail-priced at 24.99, at your local Scout Shop or online at www.scoutstuff.org.

Focus of New Manual: This manual is designed to support Sea Scouts Youth members and provides guidance and information in four main areas: 1) Ship Organization and Uniform; 2) Ship Operation; 3) Advancement and Recognition; and 4) Safety and Seamanship.

Format of New Manual: Each page is loose-leaf, in a three-hole-punch design that allows you to easily place the pages into a binder or notebook and organize as you like. There is also a new DVD/CD at the back of the manual providing supporting videos in: 1) How to tie knots; 2) How to prepare and play the boatswain's pipe; and 3) Landship setup, plus opening and closing ceremonies. CD also provides printable forms and articles that support advancement and leadership (these are not a part of the printed manual).

Update/Additions to Manual: Additional updates may be made periodically to the manual prior to the next printing. As changes or additions occur, we will make them available in a special section on the website (see below). You will be able to easily identify which page has been updated and when that change or addition occurred. Updates will be available in a PDF format for easy reference and download. So be sure to check in frequently and keep your manual up-to-date at all times.

## How and Where to Access Updates/Additions to Manual:

Here are two ways to access updates and additions to the manual:

- Go to www.seascout.org. On the home page, click on 'Resources for Youth' and you will see updates/additions listed along with the dates these occurred.
- Go to www.scouting.org, then click on 'Youth', then click on 'Venturing' to the left of the screen.
  Once the Venturing listing pops up, go to the bottom of the listing to 'Sea Scouting' and click. This will take you to the official Sea Scout Web site. Once there, click on 'Resources for Youth' and you will see updates/additions listed along with the dates these occurred.
